Objectives

 Students will be able to reflect on what Veterans Day means to them, documented through a written brainstorming chart.

 Students will be able to make and use at least 2 different stencils in their individual monoprints.

 Students will be able to create individual monoprints to incorporate into a collaborative Veterans Day piece.

* Once you have a few ideas grab a marker and write them on the brainstorming poster at the front.

Monoprinting

The monoprint is a form of printmaking where the image can only be made once, unlike most printmaking which allows for multiple originals. Combines printmaking, painting and drawing methods - creating spontaneous results.

Steps For Monoprinting

- Choose your design
- Create your plate
 - Painting
 - Paint removal
 - Stamps/Stencils
- Align paper for printing
- Place paper on top of plate
- Apply pressure
- Pull print!




Steps For Creating Stencils

- Draw design on paper
- Cut out
 - Save the cut out and cut out scraps
- Carve out of erasers or other soft material
